State	ESM
NJ	Percent of CYSHCN ages 0-18 years served by Special Child Health Services Case Management Units (SCHS CMUs) with a primary care physician and/or Shared Plan of Care (SPoC).
	Percent of CYSHCN ages 12-17 years served by Special Child Health Services Case Management Units (SCHS CMUs) with at least one transition to adulthood service.
MD	Number of parents who receive information/education on the importance of developmental screenings from Home Visiting and Care Coordination Title V provider.

Sample SPMs developed by Title V agencies

State	SPM
NJ	Percent of live children registered with the Birth Defects and Autism Reporting Systems (BDARS) who have been referred to NJ's Special Child Health Services Case Management Unit who are receiving services.

Marshall Islands	Develop and implement clinical management, guidelines and registry for children with Special Health Care Needs.
