Training & Measurement

Provides training for Results-Based Accountability and Root Cause Analysis. Conducts TA for measuring strategies and explains the evidence-base behind strategies.



Full ESM Reviews

Reviews current, state-initiated ESMs annually to provide feedback on how they align with NPMs and state strategies and how they are supported by the published evidence.



MCH Research

Develops WHAT WORKS Evidence Accelerators, which summarize the latest strategies and practices for each National Performance Measure (NPM) and Standardized Measure (SM).



Customized TA

Conducts small or large group TA with Title V teams; Identifies emerging evidence and engages in TA to develop new ESMs and guidance for implementation and measurement.
